RULES AND OBJECTS OF THE CLUB

- 1 The name of the club shall be 'The Southampton Golf Club'.
- 2 The objects of the club are to encourage sportsmanship, foster friendship and the social side of golf, and to further the interests of the Southampton Municipal Golf Course.
- 3 Membership shall be open to annual subscribers, who shall automatically cease membership if prohibited to use the course by the local authority.
- 4 The entrance fee and annual subscription are payable upon enrolment into the club and expire on 31st December each year. Renewal of subscription shall become due on 1st November each year. Members whose subscription remains unpaid at the 31st December shall be deemed to have left the club and will be subject to a re-entry fee. The entrance fee for full members is currently £40, seniors of age 65 years and above is £10 and there is no entry fee for juniors of under 18 years. The subscription fee for full members is £35 and for seniors £15, and juniors it is £10.
- 5 The general committee of the club shall consist of the Captain, Senior Org, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Competitions Secretary, Hon. Junior Organiser, the President and 6 members of the club. Five members are needed to form a quorum. The committee shall have full power to arrange all handicaps, competitions and the dates thereof, and to carry out all business relating to the club. The committee may, for ancillary purposes, co-opt other members onto committee.
- 6 The committee shall be elected annually at the AGM. They must be duly nominated and their names posted on the notice board for at least 14 days prior to the AGM. Should there be more members nominated than required then election will be by ballot at the meeting. Should there not be enough members nominated then they will be confirmed by the meeting, which may then nominate for the vacancies from the meeting.
- 7 The club shall be affiliated to the Hampshire, Isle of Wight and Channel Islands Golf Union and through them the EGU.
- 8 The Hon. Secretary shall receive an honorarium of £750 pa and the club shall provide a telephone for club use. The Hon. Competitions secretary shall receive an honorarium of £700 pa. The Hon. Treasurer shall receive an honorarium of £550 pa. The Hon. Junior Organiser shall receive an honorarium of £100 pa. The Captain shall receive £120 towards his expenses for the year. Seniors Organiser shall receive £100pa
- 9 The annual general meeting shall be held at the end of November and the Hon. Secretary shall report the progress of the club for the year. A notice shall be posted on the notice board prior to the meeting and an agenda will be posted 7 days before the meeting. The Hon. Treasurer shall present an audited financial statement for the preceding 12 months.
- 10 An extraordinary general meeting may be called at any time by a majority of the committee, or by a request in writing to the hon. Secretary signed by at least 25 members of the club and stating the nature of the business.
- 11 All competitions shall be played under the rules of the R & A of St. Andrews subject to local rules laid down by the club. All competitions cards must be signed by a member of a club affiliated to the Hants, IOW & CI Golf Union if other than a member of Southampton Men's or Ladies Golf Clubs. The club must be stated and player's name printed. To avoid the possibility of disqualification a member must ensure his name is printed clearly in the competition book in the correct division and that his entry fee is placed in the competitions box before commencing play.
- 12 In match play it is the duty of both players or pairs to arrange to complete their match by the stipulated date, or both could be disqualified. All summer knock-outs must be played from the back tees.

To qualify for these majors, members must return four completed cards from the numbered competitions of the preceding year. The year starts with the winter majors. Players may enter the club championship if they complete ten cards from numbered competitions in the same year by end of June, if they have not already qualified. Disqualified cards do not count. If any member fails to return his card for a competition he shall be debarred from taking part in any club competition for 2 months. Players with 5 cnc's in a year in handicap effective competitions, or those failing to turn up at a fun day once in, will receive a one month ban.

- 13 Members changing their address are requested to inform the Hon. Secretary of the club in writing by placing a note in the competitions box.
- 14 Any complaints must be made in writing to the Hon. Secretary who shall submit them to the committee whose decision shall be final.
- 15 Only notices authorised by the committee or the Hon. Secretary shall be posted on the notice board.
- 16 Members shall not purchase golf balls on the course.
- 17 Any member may be expelled or suspended from the club at the discretion of the committee, subject to right of appeal in writing to the Hon. Secretary within 14 days of notification, after which the committee decision shall be final.

In general it is up to all members of the club to observe the rules of etiquette of golf. Please repair pitch marks, replace divots, and rake bunkers, and never leave litter on the course. It is our course and we should look after it. And please turn off your mobile phones when playing in competitions

STANDING ORDERS

- 1 The captain, vice captain or a member of the committee shall preside at all meetings. The decision of the chairman on any point of order shall be final. He shall have a deliberate vote and a casting vote.
- 2 Any member wishing to table a motion for the AGM, which would have as its objective the formation or amendment of a rule must give 21 days notice to the honorary secretary so that the matter can be placed on the AGM agenda.
- 3 Any member wishing to speak must address himself to the chair.
- 4 When two or more members rise to speak at the same time, the chairman shall name the member who shall speak first.
- 5 No member whilst speaking shall be interrupted except on a point of order or for the purpose of explanation.
- 6 A member who speaks shall direct his remarks to the motion under discussion, or to the motion or amendment to be proposed by him, or to a question of order.
- 7 The mover of any original motion shall have the right of reply. In replying he shall not introduce new matter but shall confine himself to answering the original observations and immediately after the reply the question shall be put from the chair without further debate.
- 8 Whenever any amendment shall have been duly made and seconded upon an original motion, such amendment shall be the first to the vote and no subsequent amendment shall be taken into consideration until the first amendment has been disposed of. If the first amendment be carried then it shall displace the original motion and become the substantive motion for consideration, whereupon any further amendment may be moved. If the first amendment be negated, a second or further one may be moved, but only one may be discussed at a time. Any member may have the right to move that the question be now put unless he has taken part in the discussion.
- 9 When the amendment is lost and the original motion is put, or when an amendment has been carried and has become the substantive motion and no other amendment is moved, no member shall be allowed to speak.
- 10 When the chairman rises to speak no one shall continue speaking until the chair has been resumed.
- 11 In matters of urgent importance standing orders may be suspended by a two-thirds majority of members present and voting at the meeting.

GENERAL NOTES OF GUIDANCE TO MEMBERS

Matchplay

- 1 All matches must be completed by the due dates which are given in this diary.
- 2 All competitors are equally responsible for arranging the match.
- 3 If you experience any difficulty arranging a match within the first week of any round, contact the Secretary or Competitions Secretary at once.
- 4 Players must be able to offer at least one week-end date to opponents, and three dates in total.
- 5 Disqualification will result if matches are not played on time, and entry into future competitions may be withdrawn by the committee.
- 6 All players are responsible for knowing the conditions and format of the competition, and any deadline dates.
- 7 The Secretary must be aware of your telephone number either by posting it in the box or writing it on the matchplay sheets.
- 8 Players may play on the course before any match, on the day.

Strokeplay

- 1 To enter any strokeplay competition members must print their name in the competition book, and post the entry fee in an envelope with their name and the competition clearly written on it, before they go on the course.
- 2 Players cannot play a strokeplay event on the course if they have already played on the course that day.
- 3 Cards must be returned, even if the player cannot get out on the course, once the competition has been entered.
- 4 Players can only tee off after 7.15 am to ensure their entry may not be voided if the Greenkeepers have to change the course. Teeing off before this is allowed but if the course is changed their round will be made null and void.
- 5 To qualify for Major Competitions, four of the numbered strokeplay events must be completed. Disqualified cards or incomplete cards do not count.
